English: Our writing focus this half term is to write a 'rag to riches' story and a persuasive leaflet about pirates and a treasure island using the book: On a Pirate Ship!

Home readers will be sent home on Tuesday this week. We change our books every Monday.

Spelling: Each week we have a spelling test every Friday morning, spelling is ideally learnt by repetition so please revise the weekly words daily. This Friday we will assess our Common Exception Words so that we have a baseline assessment.

Maths: We will be focussing on sequencing of numbers - counting on and back and number bonds to 20 with links to 100. Mental maths will take place for 15 minutes - 4 afternoons a week.

Science: Everyday Materials - we will look at the use of every day materials and how changes to the environment cause them to change.

Our scientist for this term is: Charles Macintosh.

Geography: An Island Home - we learn about the countries of the UK, and use the fictional 'Katie Morag' and her Scottish island home which is based on the actual island the Isle of Coll.

Art: we will explore mark marking, using a range of materials, as part of our nature focus. At this time of year with all the autumn colours we would love some Autumn items from your garden or local area for our display table. Our Artist is: Giuseppe Arcimboldo

P.E. and Forest School: are both on Thursday so please make sure your child has both kits at school. Children with long hair do need to tie up their hair for P.E. lessons. For forest school a weather proof forest school kit and wellies are to be kept at school (there is a wellie rack just outside our classroom door).
