<u>Literacy</u>

One of the foundations for story-writing success is being able to retell this story. As the term progresses, we will change the story and the children will have an opportunity to write their own version of the story.

In maths we are continuing with developing our subitising skills. We are focusing on the number 7 and using our gestures to find two numbers that you can add together to make 7.
