Autumn Term 1 Menu & Allergen Chart



School meal prices have increased to £2.40 for nursery pupils and £2.90 for school pupils. For children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, they are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals as part of the Government scheme, however, it imperative that you book their meal choice on ParentPay. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, there will be no charge for school meals.

This week in...

Reception Class: This week Reception are now in school full time. We have spent time learning how a story map works and learning to retell the story of the Little Red Hen. We have been thinking about who is in our family and sharing photos of our family with the class.

We have learnt The Big Number song and are beginning to learn to write our names.

Year 1 Class: This week year 1 have found out what our story focus will be this half term in literacy. To help them figure out what story we would be learning about the children did a treasure hunt around the school grounds where they searched for picture clues. When we got back to the classroom we discussed what the book might be and the children were sure it was the three little pigs, and it was! Then we sat together and enjoyed reading the story. We look forward to learning more about the story as the term goes on.

Year 2 Class: This week Year 2 have been pirates and were able to tell and act out our pirate story to Year 3 who were very impressed. In addition, today we have begun identifying leaves on different trees and making portraits using natural materials in Forest School.

Year 3 Class: Have really delved deep into their Ancient Greece project this week. They have worked hard learning about democracy, the Olympics and designed Ancient Greek vases. They have also done incredibly well learning their new text 'The King of the Fishes', preparing them to write their own wishing tale.

Year 4 Class: Year 4 have had a very busy week and have worked extremely hard. Swimming was a great success on Wednesday and it was wonderful seeing the children enjoy it so much. In maths, the children have been motivated with their daily times table challenges, as well as learning to recognise the addend and sum in addition calculations. In our history topic, the children have started to make some perceptive comparisons between the Iron Age and how things changed when the Romans settled in Britain. Finally, a definite highlight of this week is the introduction of their Reception buddies and next week they will have the opportunity to write their new friends a letter.

Rainbow Woods Pre-School: This week we have been concentrating on introducing our daily routines to the new children and making sure we are all sharing, taking turns and being kind to each other. We have also been talking about our feelings and how we all experience them, but we all react differently. We then spoke about how we are feeling now, and what makes us feel happy, sad, excited or frightened. Alongside this we have been reading the book, "The colour monster", and using different colours to express our emotions in our pictures.

We have also been working on our topic "All about me" and creating a display board with all of our self-portraits.

Each half term we focus on a Christian Value, this term it is Thankfulness
