If you would like to participate in the scarecrow trail, trail maps are now available. All money raised is will be going to the school pta.


Allergies:

This week in...

Reception Class: In Reception this week we have been making story maps for the story of the Little Red Hen. We have been thinking about faces and using loose parts to create a face. We were super excited to have been given our home reader books to take home. In maths we have been talking about skills we can use to count objects accurately. We also had a visit from Mrs Hyett who was our mystery reader this week. In RE we have continued learning about the story of creation.

Year 1 Class: This week in year 1 we have finished our topic 'why do we recycle'. The children learnt what it means to be environmentally friendly and each made a poster that could teach others how to be environmentally friendly. In science this week the children worked so well in teams to sort each material under its correct heading and then label each material with a description of its properties e.g. glass is transparent. We also played an 'odd one out game' in our table groups and the children worked together to work out which item on the 4 trays was the odd one out. In English we have innovated the three little pigs to the three little fish, with the big bad shark! The children will write out their new story next week.

Year 2 Class: this week has been so exciting with our amazing island creations arriving each day - so much thought has gone into their design. In Maths we have been learning how to add and subtract using a number line it's been quite challenging but we have been working with our talking partners to support each other!

Year 3 Class have been incredibly creative this week in our Ancient Greece lessons. On Monday we learnt about the columns that were built on Greek Temples, we designed our own Greek column in our sketch books and then used chalk on black paper to create a final piece. On Tuesday, we learnt about how the Ancient Greeks had to weave to make their own clothes, bedding and wall hangings. We had a go at weaving some wool together which was very successful and we now have a beautiful display of them in our classroom.

Year 4 Class This week Year 4 enjoyed inspecting each other's teeth during science - identifying the different types of teeth we all have and their functions. During our History/ Art lesson this week, the children painted their Roman clay pots using geometric patterns. On Friday, the children will be getting festive early and designing their Christmas cards. Finally, a huge well done to our Tag Rugby stars who won our first tournament at HSMS on Wednesday!

Rainbow Woods Pre-School: This week we have been continuing to talk about what we're thankful for and we've had some really beautiful answers from the children that we have put up on our Christian Values display. We have been talking about all the different fruits and colours we see in Autumn on our forest school walks and we have counted and displayed the items we have found and talked about why some animals are foraging for food ready to hibernate and why birds fly to warmer countries at this time of year. We have enjoyed some fruit painting and even enjoyed starting our Christmas cards!
