Year 4 Swimming

Year 4 have enjoyed their first half term of swimming at Kings Leisure Centre.

Just to confirm: swimming lessons are funded by the school and we only request payment for the coach transport to and from school. They have thoroughly enjoyed their sessions at Kings Leisure which provides us with 3 swimming coaches for each lesson, so the children are taught all at the same time, in three small groups to optimise their learning.

Year 4 will continue their lessons for the second half of the Autumn term and then there will be one more lesson on 10th January to make up one lost to our Christmas performance on 6th December. Something for Year 3 to look forward to in the Spring term.

This week in...

Reception Class: this week we have started our new story of A Squash and a Squeeze and our new topic this term is 'It's A Party'. In maths we have been using language to describe amounts using 'more than ' and 'fewer than'. We have been scooping out pumpkins and using tweezers to collect the seeds. In RE we have talked about our Christian values of compassion and kindness.

Year 1 Class: this week year 1 began their new topic 'polar explorers'. Our Geography enquiry is 'Why are some places in the world always cold'. In our first Geography lesson we have done lots of map work, finding the North pole, the South Pole and the Equator and labelling them on our own maps. We learnt that the countries near the equator are very hot and because the North and South Pole are far away from the equator, they are very cold. They also learnt that the South pole is actually a desert because it hasn't had rainfall in over 2 million years!

Year 2 Class: We have had great first week back after the break. We have explored Giuseppie Arcimbaldo's style of using food items when creating portraits. This afternoon we all had a go at using the vegetables and fruit in the classroom and creating portraits it was such fun. Look out on Class Dojo for photos!

Year 3 Class have had a good first week back after half term. We started our new geography topic on rivers and learnt about the key features of a river and how erosion takes place to form meanders. We have also been busy innovating our non-chronological reports in English and are building up our skills to write our own ones independently next week.

Year 4 Class has had a very exciting week. On Monday, the children were invited to attend auditions for this year's Christmas play, 'A Magical Christmas Jigsaw'. It was wonderful to see so many of them there. On Tuesday, they were given their parts and we did our first run-through of the play - a positive start. In English, we have started a new writing unit based on 'warning stories'. They particularly enjoyed performing the model text to the rest of the class, using their own story maps. On Friday, the children created some really effective firework pictures using oil pastels. Wishing you a wonderful weekend of fireworks and carnivals - a magical time of year.

Rainbow Woods Pre-School: Our topic this term is all about celebrations and what a full packed week we have had already. We have been learning about Guy Fawkes, making firework and fire pictures. We have also been talking about how we can be safe around fires and fireworks. We have started to talk about Diwali and what other parties and festivals are celebrated in different countries -What they wear and eat too. In forest school we have been practicing our numbers 0-10 finding different items to count and talking about their colours and how they feel too. Next week we will be talking about Remembrance Sunday and celebrating Diwali-The children are very excited about seeing Baishali's Rangoli Designs to welcome Goddess Laxmi.

Each half term we focus on a Christian Value, this term it is Kindness and Compassion
