Year 3 Class Year 3 had a fun-filled Wednesday with the pantomime and no pens day. We started the morning by seeing what we could build out of Lego, everyone had different pieces so every model was very unique! For maths, we used number cards to order numbers 0-1000, in English we painted our next part of our little red riding hood story rather than writing it and to finish off for Geography/DT we built bridges to go over rivers.

Year 4: Year 4 have had a whirlwind week. It was wonderful to see the rest of the school's songs, bringing together our play and completing our jigsaw. In addition to this, the children had an extremely busy and productive afternoon on Tuesday, in our Christmas Biscuit Bake Off. They have made lots of festive biscuits ready to sell at the Christmas fayre. Another highlight was the pantomime on Wednesday - the children booed and hissed and joined in with lots of the songs - it was a fantastic atmosphere. In the afternoon, they learnt some vital life-saving skills during their swimming lesson, where they were dressed in pjs. A memorable week!


