The missed football session from Autumn term will take place on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> January so no refund will be issued.

Please note: Places are limited and are first come first served.

If your child is attending a sports club they will need to bring their PE kit into school to change into if they do not already have PE on that day.

All clubs finish at 4.30 pm, please collect your child promptly from the double gates in the playground.

If your child is attending one of the above clubs and their sibling is in wrap around care, could you please collect children separately at the allocated gates (for after school wrap around care this will be the side gate onto the road and the above clubs it is the double gates in the playground).

#### How to Book

Places are booked through Parent Pay, if you are unable to book the session it means that all the places have been taken. The office will not issue any confirmation slips.

If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium, there will be no charge for them attending the club. To book your child a place, you will need to contact the school office.

If the cost of a school club causes a financial problem for any parent, please contact Mrs Warren in the office. Please note, that it is school policy to support payment or make payment in full, for families whose circumstances qualify and that the school receives Pupil Premium Funding for their child. If you think you are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding or if you would like information on how families qualify for Pupil Premium Funding, please contact the office.

## AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

### Management of 'After School Clubs'

While we are keen to promote attendance at these clubs, it is also essential that we ensure a positive experience for every child participating. This means that decisions will have to be made, in advance, about the age range a particular club is open to. The age limits will reflect the scope of the club and the necessary management, in order to provide the very best outcome for your child.

#### **Behaviour Management Policy for After School Clubs**

At Weare Academy First School we believe that it is vitally important that everyone is safe and happy within it. Our Behaviour Management Policy states the expectations that we have for the way in which each member of our school community should conduct themselves.

#### **Golden Rules**

Our pupils understand how the Golden Rules apply to each part of their school life. For example in the playground, being kind includes playing well with others and making sure others are included. If an adult is confident that a child has an understanding of the 'School Rules' and is able to differentiate between right and wrong, yet behaves in a way that is unacceptable, it will be necessary to use sanctions as a deterrent. After School Clubs will follow our Behaviour Management Policy in the following way:-

1/If a child misbehaves they will be given a warning

2/If they misbehave again, they will sit 'out' of the club for a period of time (within sight and supervision of the club leader).

3/If they misbehave again, they will be asked to miss their club for one week.

4/Extreme behaviour towards an adult or another child will not be tolerated (eg. hitting, kicking, spitting, swearing, abuse or similar) and NO WARNING will be given. For such an incident, the child will be excluded from the club. Please note that there will be no refund of club payment for excluded pupils.
