#### This week in...

Reception Class: this week we have started our new topic this term which is 'The Great Outdoors'. We have heard the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff and have learnt lots of fun and interesting facts about goats. We have been thinking about keeping our bodies healthy and have been talking about our Christian value of the term which is forgiveness. In Forest School we went on a wellie walk around the school to spot signs of spring.

Year 1 Class: This week in year one the children have begun their new literacy unit 'Mr Gumpy's outing' (Mr Gumpy owns a boat and his house was by a river) by making boats out of junk modelling! The children worked thoughtfully and carefully to design and make a boat to fit the design criteria "To make a boat that will float on water". The children tested their boats on Friday afternoon and what a massive success! The children, Mrs Malcolm and Miss Baker all had a fantastic time with this DT project. Thank you to the parents for donating so much recycling!

Year 2 Class: Our challenge this week has been to sew our Torah covers, we have made a good start but we will complete these next week. Mrs Hugh has been very pleased with the results so far. We have also been learning all about doubling and the link to the 2 times tables and we have used a range of resources helping us to understand and apply our new learning.

Year 3 Class: This week Year 3 started their new history topic about the Stone Age to the Iron Age, we looked closely at Skara Brae and Stonehenge and drew some fantastic pictures of them.

In English we have completed our invent writes this week of our explanations, each child chose an animal that has gone extinct and has written an explanation on why it could have gone extinct.

Year 4 Class: have had a great first week back. The children have enthusiastically started their new unit of writing, looking at instruction texts based on our model text, 'How to Make a Teacher Happy'. Next week we will go on to innovate our own versions of instructions based on 'How to Make a Pupil Happy', which will be interesting to read... In Computing the children have been reminded about the importance of e-safety and how to protect ourselves from potential dangers. As a school, we have launched the Zones of Regulation - providing the children with strategies and vocabulary to support their varying emotions. We have gone on to discuss this in class and I am sure it will act as an important aid as the children become more familiar with it.

Rainbow Woods Pre-School: This week we have welcomed new starters and introduced our new topics for this term-The Great Outdoors and The Very Hungry Caterpillar. The children have measured out the ingredients and made playdough from scratch. They have made different colours and used shapes to mould the caterpillar. They have also painted blossom on trees using cotton buds. We have also made a story board for The Very Hungry Caterpillar where the children had to put the pictures in order and count out the different foods the Caterpillar ate. We spoke about how our bodies grow and the different stages the caterpillar grows.

Each half term we focus on a Christian Value, this term it is Forgiveness

Exciting news! It's back. We are planning to run our Football Academy once again this summer. The Football Academy is centred around children of all abilities and ages having an enjoyable football experience whilst learning new skills. Our goal is that all children have a fantastic time, have fun, and make friends through playing football.

The academy begins on **Monday 29th July** and finishes on **Thursday 1st of August**, starting at **9am** and finishing at **4pm**. The academy is open to children from **Year 1 – Year 11**. It will be held at Hugh Sexey Middle School, Blackford, Wedmore, BS28 4ND. The timetable incorporates a mix of training, tactics, tournaments, competitions, and fitness. We aim to deliver high quality coaching whilst the children enjoy themselves participating in tournaments, games, and challenges.

The academy is staffed by teachers/qualified FA coaches who are First Aid trained and have experience of coaching children. The cost per child will be **£100** for the four days or **£30** for a day. We hope you agree this offers excellent value for money considering the level of coaching and activities provided. Each child will leave with a **Participation Medal and a Football**. Throughout the four days there are plenty of chances to win prizes, trophies, and various medals in all types of competitions such as Crossbar Challenge, 5 sec shootout and Penalty Shootout. On the final day there is a presentation ceremony where prizes and medals are given out.

Next week from Tuesday 27 February to Saturday 2 March, the 'Crown and Coronation' light show, an immersive spectacle of the Crown Jewels and Coronations, is coming to Wells Cathedral.
