This week in...

Reception Class: this week we have made story maps for the story of the Billy Goats Gruff. In maths we have been comparing quantities using the language of more and fewer. World book day activities were great fun and the children all looked amazing in their costumes. In RE we had a joint trip with year 2 to visit Park Row synagogue in Bristol to learn all about a Jewish place of worship.

Year 1 Class: this week year 1 have been coming up with adjectives to describe the setting of Mr Gumpy's outing. The children thought of many different adjectives to describe both Mr Gumpys boat and the river next to his house. To end the week we all made cheese and broccoli scones!

Year 2 Class: Wow, we have had a great week. On Monday we had a great introduction to our new History topic, Florence Nightingale, the children dressed up, bandaged each other and had a great morning. Today we visited a synagogue and our children did us proud when they were able to explain that they had made torah scrolls and covers to the vice president of the synagogue. It has been a busy but very productive week.

Year 3 Class: we have had an exciting week in Year 3. We started the week with our school trip to Carymoor for a Stone Age day. When we arrived, we went over to the round house and did some fire lighting, every child managed to produce a spark! Then we built some stone age shelters out of huge sticks, the children really enjoyed this and were covered head to toe in mud by the end of this activity. During the afternoon we then used some magnifying glasses to look at some stone age artefacts and had a go at predicting what they were used for.

Wednesday was also a fun-filled day with World Book Day, Year 3 went off with their house groups around the different classes to complete a variety of different activities such as illustrating, finger puppets, book covers and book making. It has been an extremely enjoyable week!

Year 4 Class: Weare has been buzzing this week. The Willy Wonky bars were a great hit across the school. On Wednesday, we celebrated World Book Day and the children looked fantastic dressed up as their favourite book characters and enjoyed our caroussel of activities in their House Teams - it was so lovely seeing all of the year groups collaboratively working together. On Friday, we celebrated the children's amazing Ancient Greek homework projects, with our traditional award ceremony. The children proudly showed off their creations with their friends. Overall, a wonderful week in Year 4 and across the school, making memories.

Exciting news! It's back. We are planning to run our Football Academy once again this summer. The Football Academy is centred around children of all abilities and ages having an enjoyable football experience whilst learning new skills. Our goal is that all children have a fantastic time, have fun, and make friends through playing football.

The academy begins on **Monday 29th July** and finishes on **Thursday 1st of August**, starting at **9am** and finishing at **4pm**. The academy is open to children from **Year 1 – Year 11**. It will be held at Hugh Sexey Middle School, Blackford, Wedmore, BS28 4ND. The timetable incorporates a mix of training, tactics, tournaments, competitions, and fitness. We aim to deliver high quality coaching whilst the children enjoy themselves participating in tournaments, games, and challenges.

The academy is staffed by teachers/qualified FA coaches who are First Aid trained and have experience of coaching children. The cost per child will be £100 for the four days or £30 for a day. We hope you agree this offers excellent value for money considering the level of coaching and activities provided. Each child will leave with a Participation Medal and a Football. Throughout the four days there are plenty of chances to win prizes, trophies, and various medals in all types of competitions such as Crossbar Challenge, 5 sec shootout and Penalty Shootout. On the final day there is a presentation ceremony where prizes and medals are given out.
