#### This week in...

Reception Class: In Reception this week we have continued to look at the lifecycle of a plant and writing labels. In maths we have continued with measuring. We have enjoyed some cooking and have made Easter nests. We have had some lovely new resources arrive at school which have kindly been donated by parents, grandparents and a local business. The children's faces light up when we have had a special delivery and have enjoyed using our new resources this week. We have been busy practising our performance for the Easter service this week and have made our own Easter bonnets. We have been talking about the Easter story and how Christian's celebrate Easter.

Year 1 Class: This week has been super busy in year 1. We have finished writing our own journey stories, remembering to include lots of wonderful adjectives to describe the setting. We have also created beautiful Easter bonnets and cards and they all looked fantastic! The children performed their part of the Easter service in the church so well and all spoke so clearly! Well done children. See you next half term.

Year 2 Class: The Ladybird class visit to the Bristol Aquarium was amazing. The photos on Class Dojo are just a glimpse of a super day. Our children did themselves proud as staff members commented on how well behaved Weare School was. Mrs Hugh and Miss Green reported that the children asked really thoughtful questions and at times challenged the leader of the guided tour! Our Easter bonnets were absolutely beautifully made and our children proudly wore them in front of the whole school for the Easter Bonnet parade. We have had another great week and on behalf of the Ladybird Class team wish you all a lovely, fun and restful Easter Break.

Year 3 Class: Have had a busy, arty week, we ended our stone age topic by completing some stone age cave paintings. We layered up our pictures by using wax crayons to draw animals and then painted handprints over the top using a template. We have also been busy with our Easter crafts, we have made Easter bonnets and Easter baskets and have enjoyed practising our poem for the Easter Service.

Year 4 Class: Have had a very busy and exciting final week of term, making an abundance of Easter goodies. Their bonnets looked fantastic and we loved parading around in them with the rest of the school. I was so proud of all of the children in the Easter service. They wrote some beautiful and very powerful acrostic poems about the crucifixion, which we collectively created a class poem from. Some of the children read the poem during the service, and others presented their stain glass crosses having chosen different colours to symbolise different parts of the Easter story. Wishing everyone a peaceful and happy Easter holiday and I look forward to welcoming them all back for our final summer term together.

Rainbow Woods Pre-School: This week we have had the best fun celebrating Holi running around with the school children and being part of the whole school service too. We managed to speak to some of the Year 3 children in the playground who were talking to our children about when they start year 4 and become buddies-Very sweet little conversations were had. On Wednesday we also walked with the school up to St Gregory's for the Easter Service where our children sang and signed out their favourite song. We also had a visit from Nikki's lambs and Nikki talked about how she is looking after them, what they drink and eat to help them to grow. The children loved stroking them and having a turn at feeding them a bottle of milk. They have also completed their decorated cards and bags and we popped in a little treat for them all to enjoy from the Easter bunny! Have a wonderful break and we will see you all in two weeks including our new children starting their new beginnings! We look forward to seeing you all on our return and welcoming our new starters to our Rainbow Woods family.
