## This week in...

# Rainbow Woods Preschool



We have returned this week with a spring in our step! What a fun week we have had welcoming our children back to start a new term. We have been talking about zoo and farm animals, the sounds they make, the food they eat and where they live. We have made playdough houses for our zoo and farm animals and explored the different materials in forest school that we would need to make a home for our farm animals like mud, straw and wood. We have painted some beautiful pictures of our wild flowers and explored the new plants and insects we have in our forest school.

#### Reception



In Reception this week we have been learning our new talk for writing story called 'The Sheep and the Goat', we have been excited to start our new topic called The Animal Kingdom. We have looked at the patterns found on animal fur and skin and have used printing to make our own animal prints. In Forest School and music we have learnt a song all about a snail and made our own snail trails. In maths we have continued with subitising with the number 6 and using objects to represent our thinking. In RE we have talked about stories that give us a special message and have talked about the story of the wise man who built his house upon the rock and the foolish man who built his house upon the sand. We have linked the story to our Christian value of responsibility.

Year 1



This week in year 1 we have enjoyed getting to know our new head teacher, Mrs Dover. On Thursday she came to read us a story. We have also enjoyed beginning to learn about our new topic, Castles! On Friday we all created our own coat of arms for our display.

Year 2



We have had a great start to the term measuring using capacity which also involves earning to read a scale with different increments - counting in 100's, 50's. We have worked with our talking partners to see how many cups or milk cartons or plastic bottles are needed to fill a 1 litre container. Our home challenge is to measure how much water it takes to fill our drinks bottles. We have also completed our Joseph Coat symmetrical designs which are absolutely beautiful and we have discussed what means to have 'creative licence'!

Year 3



We have had a busy and productive week back in Year 3. In math's we have revised our column addition method that we learnt last half term and have been using it to solve problems, we are now coming to the end of it and will be starting to focus on our four times table next week. In English we have started to learn a new model text called "The Cobbler of Krakow and Smok the Dragon", this is a defeating the monster tale and we have created some beautiful story boards of it. We have also started our new history topic this week all about how our homes have changed over time, we have so far looked at how food, kitchen utensils and washing utensils have developed since the Victorians.

#### Year 4



Year 4 thoroughly enjoyed our first science lesson about electricity, asking thought provoking and insightful questions, before categorising items into non- electrical, battery operated and mains electric. We have also started our new writing topic, learning to write a portal story using 'Elf Road' as our model text. The children had some excellent ideas for their Cold Write and lots are getting extremely close to their much anti pen licenses... very exciting! Finally, a super proud moment - our wonderful Year 4s won the TT Rockstar tournament against all of the other classes across the Trust, including several year 7 teams - an absolutely amazing achievement, well done all!
