## **YEAR 4 - KILVE COURT RESIDENTIAL CENTRE** **12<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025**

We are pleased to inform you about the Year 4 residential trip which will take place at Kilve Court Residential Centre near Bridgwater from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

Kilve Court is a site run by SSE Outdoors, a company that runs children's adventure activity holidays. We have been attending Kilve Court Residential Centre for a number of years and are very happy with the service they provide. The activity centre is run by appropriately qualified and trained staff and a number of Weare staff will also be attending the trip. The aims of the trip are both educational and fun, they are intended to give your child the opportunity to develop independence, to interact closely with their peers and engage in a range of challenging activities led by qualified instructors and supported by Weare staff.

The total cost of the trip is £236.00 and covers the cost of accommodation, meals, activities and coach travel.

A deposit payment of £10.00 will be due by the 13<sup>th</sup> December 2025 via Parentpay, where you will also consent to your child attending the trip. By consenting for your child to go on the trip you are confirming that you are aware that Weare Academy Church of England First School only provides cover against proved or agreed negligence by the Academy and its employees and that you should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for school activities in the UK.

The balance payment of £226.00 can be paid either in full or in instalments of your choice, the full payment will need to be made by Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025.
