It's that time of year again! We are planning to run our Football Academy this summer. The Football Academy is centred around children of all abilities and ages having an enjoyable football experience whilst learning new skills. Our aim is that all children have a fantastic time, have fun, and make friends through playing football.

The academy begins on **Monday 28th July** and finishes on **Thursday 31st of July**, starting at **9am** and finishing at **4pm**. The academy is open to children from **Year 1 – Year 11**. It will be held at Hugh Sexey Middle School, Blackford, Wedmore, BS28 4ND. The timetable incorporates a mix of training, tactics, tournaments, competitions, and fitness. We aim to deliver high quality coaching whilst the children enjoy themselves participating in tournaments, games, and challenges.

The academy is staffed by teachers/qualified FA coaches who are First Aid trained and have experience of coaching children. The cost per child will be **£100** for the four days or **£30** for a day.
