## Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we come to the end of another busy and successful term, I would like to take a moment to reflect on some of the highlights and share a few final updates.

Our Easter service at the Church was truly special. The children sang beautifully and shared the Easter message with such confidence and meaning – by the end, there was not a dry eye in the house (myself included!). It was a lovely way to come together as a community and celebrate the end of term.

This term we have also celebrated many of our children through our Behaviour Star badges. Due to the sheer number of pupils being recognised, badges were awarded during an in-school service. An incredible 17 children achieved a silver badge, alongside many, many bronze awards! A fantastic achievement and something we are very proud of.

To provide some clarity around how the behaviour points system works: children earn positive points through Class Dojo, which are added to our behaviour tracking system across the term. Where negative behaviours result in a sanction, points may be deducted. The overall total of positive points is then used to award badges. This is still a new system and we are continuing to refine it, including gathering pupil voice next term to help make it as meaningful and motivating as possible.

A quick reminder regarding our Smartwatch Policy. To minimise distractions and protect pupil privacy, smartwatches brought into school must be used strictly for telling the time. Features such as cameras, games and messaging must be disabled during school hours. If these features cannot be turned off, the watch should remain at home. Thank you for your continued support with this.

Finally, a reminder that our fundraising campaign for a new all-weather outdoor classroom, in memory of our colleague **Alysia Sampson**, is still underway. Thank you to everyone who has supported so far - every contribution is helping us move closer to creating a very special space for our children. 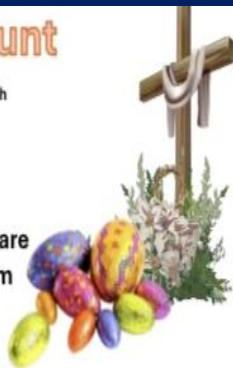
